Next month at the Tualatin Plains Presbyterian Church, [Dr. Leanne Van Dyk](#) will lead the Exploring Our Reformed Faith seminar on **October 22 – 23, 1999**. Her topic is *What Wondrous Love Is This: the startling claims of atonement doctrine*.

Dr. Leanne Van Dyk, formerly of San Francisco Theological Seminary, is the associate professor of Reformed Theology at Western Theological Seminary in Holland, Michigan. A graduate of Calvin College, Calvin Theological Seminary (M.Div.) and Princeton Theological Seminary (Ph.D.), Leanne is a member of the PCUSA. She was one of the members of the PCUSA’s Special Committee to Write a New Catechism which produced documents approved by the General Assembly in 1998. Her publications include a book, “The Desire of Divine Love; John McLeod Campbell’s Doctrine of the Atonement,” and a wide variety of articles in journals and church-related periodicals. It is quite an honor and a blessing that we will be able to host such a gifted speaker.
