

Outdoor In-Person Worship Begins!

On Sunday, June 20, outdoor in-person worship begins at 10 AM! Please come early to park safely, to find a good place to sit, and to greet others. Depending on when Oregon meets the 70% vaccination threshold, we hope to move inside soon!

Recommendations for attendees:

- Bring your own chair or blanket to sit on.
- Bring a water bottle if it's warm.
- Bring an umbrella/parasol for rain or sunshine.
- Masks or shields are recommended, especially during singing, but not required as we can be physically distant.
- Vaccines are recommended, but not required. However, if not vaccinated we strongly encourage you to wear your mask for the safety of our children and those vulnerable.
- Families with children too young for the vaccine are welcome, as each family makes their own choice (no nursery will be offered). However, please make sure they are kept within your family pod and are accompanied by an adult if needing to roam.
- An offering box will be available for giving at a stationary place, but will not be passed, and mailed tithes and offerings will continue.
- Bulletins will be available with hymns, but we request you take yours with you when you leave.
- One bathroom will be open and will have Clorox wipes available so you can wipe down surfaces after using. However, use of the bathroom is at your discretion.
- Parking is still recommended for the back lot, due to traffic, with front spaces available for those with mobility issues. (Please see the parking safety page in this mailing.)
